Parking Policy

The Fortville-Vernon Township Public Library (hereinafter the "Library") endeavors to create a welcoming environment inside the building and on Library grounds. Use of Library parking lot must conform to applicable laws, regulations, and the Acceptable Behavior Policy for Library Users. Library parking lots are intended for the use of the customers of the Library.

Purpose: To establish the policy and procedures to address behavior or activities in Library parking lot that violate laws, regulations, or Library Acceptable Behavior Policy and to provide for the removal of vehicles from Library parking lot when vehicles present a hazard, violate regulations, appear to be abandoned, or when individuals within vehicles in Library parking lot engage in illegal activity or violate the Library Acceptable Behavior Policy.

The Fortville-Vernon Township Public Library has one parking lot adjacent to the building.

This area is designated for library patrons to park their vehicles while they are using the library, and for library employees or vendors while they are working in the library.

Unauthorized use of the parking areas includes:

- Parking vehicles not belonging to patrons using the library
- Parking vehicles overnight
- Blocking or obstructing library entrances or the book return
- Loitering
- Skateboarding and rollerblading
- Soliciting
- Dumping or littering on library grounds

Unauthorized vehicles may be towed, at the owners' expense.

The library is not responsible for items that are stolen from vehicles or for damage done to vehicles parked on library property.
